**Notice of Submission of the
Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District 2011-2029**

Notice is given in accordance with Regulation 22(3) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that Daventry District Council has submitted the Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government on 19th December 2018, for independent examination.

Daventry District Council has prepared the new Local Plan (Part 2) which, if and when it is adopted, will replace the saved policies of the 1997 Local Plan and will supplement and in one instance, supersede the policies in the West Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy (Part 1), and form part of the development plan for the District.

The Proposed Submission Version of the Local Plan (Part 2) was published in August 2018 for public consultation. All parties who made representations (comments) on the plan at Proposed Submission stage will be contacted directly with more information in due course.

Part of the process will involve hearing sessions where those invited to attend will have the opportunity to respond to matters raised by the Inspector. Please note that invitation to participate is co-ordinated through the Planning Inspector and the Programme Officer, both of whom are independent from Daventry District Council. Information, such as the hearing sessions and agendas will be made available on the Council’s website when available. Notice will be given at least 6 weeks before the opening of the hearing sessions. The format of the hearings will be a matter for the Inspector.
