Update on Brightwell Pavilion refurbishment – October 2022

Many villagers will have noticed that the extensive work to modernise the Brightwell Pavilion has been underway for a number of weeks and so far things are going well. Some of the highlights of work includes:

- Replace external decked areas with stone effect paving & provide level disabled access
- Repair potholes on access track.
- Installation of land drainage system to west of playing field to prevent water logging.
- Installation of Rainwater Harvester
- New energy efficient electric boilers
- New Communal showers
- New Disabled shower
- New Toilets and urinals
- For the first time – dedicated female changing facilities
- Provide new fitted kitchen & servery facilities including sink and freestanding cooker.
- Create provision for new licensed bar area and servery to house under counter fridges.
- Complete rewiring, replumbing, new heating and hot water system and redecoration

This work is being undertaken by Byfield Parish Council supervised by an executive committee consisting of Cllrs Christl Davis, Santon Crowshaw and John Gillic. Cllr Crowshaw has devoted many hours of his own time to the project and indeed even volunteered as free labour on site, it is his efforts that are taking this project forward for the community.

We look forward to updating you on this amazing new facility as work progresses.
